## EuroMed - 2030 Long term challenges for the Mediterranean area



This publication benefited from the results of the group of experts "EuroMed-2030", which was established by DG Research and Innovation in 2010 with the aim to analyse trends, tensions and transitions in the Mediterranean area in 2010- 2030.

The report collects data concerning trends in the fields of demography and macroeconomics, water and agriculture, energy and climate change, education and science, religion and culture, and geopolitics and governance.

Moreover it identifies tensions among socio-economic groups, between competing visions of State and reform, between hostile States and between the expectations of euro-Mediterranean cooperation.

Finally, four transitions for the future Euro-Mediterranean relations are presented: managing conflict, win-win projects, deeper economic integration and towards a Euro-Mediterranean Community.
